Making A Greater Difference

1. Confidence to make a greater difference comes from trusting the truth claims of Christ (John 14:1-6).
2. Motivation to make a greater difference finds its inspiration from a deeper knowledge of the Father (John 14:7-11).
3. Power to make a greater difference comes from believing in Jesus and asking Him to get involved (John 14:12-14).
