Things We Worry About

What Does The Future Hold For Me?

INTRO.

1. The future is not pretty for those who trust in people
(Jeremiah 17:5-6; 9-10).
2. The future is promising for those who trust the Lord
(Jeremiah 17:7-8).

Action point:

If you want to experience a life free of worry and fear it comes as we trust the Lord. That has a beginning point and an ongoing aspect. You are placing your trust in something right now. It is either human or divine. If it is divine it is either Jesus or something else. The God of the Bible tells us that the beginning point of a person's spiritual life begins when we place our trust in Him by asking Jesus to save us. If you have not done that, I urge you to bow your head and do that right now. If you have already done that, then take the next step of trusting God with the details of your life. Give them to Him in prayer. And then continue investing in God, by spending time with Him, and investing in the ministries He desires. Like investing in stocks when they are down is tough to do, so continuing to invest in God is tough to do, but the payoff will be sweet. He is still the place to invest even in tough times.
