

The Power of One

1. *If power over weakness is ours for the asking, why don't we see it more? (Ephesians 3:14-17).*
2. *Figuring out how to be grounded in the love of Christ opens our lives to all that God has to offer (Ephesians 3:17-19).*
3. *God loves to empower us to do beyond what we could even conceive of doing on our own (Ephesians 3:20-21).*

Action point:

If you are simply surviving your life, then you need to ask yourself what you are doing that is blocking God's power out of it? Make a list of those things that may be blocking God's blessing in your life. Then write a second list which will include steps of faith you could take in those areas. Write them down even if they seem scary or impossible to do. Then take the one that you really want to see change and make a plan. Keep tweaking the plan and praying over it. As you pray, pray through this passage. Get advice from people who know the scriptures. Then set a date when you will carry it out. Just doing that will make your heart beat faster. On that date, take a step of faith trusting the Lord. It may be the hardest thing you ever do in your life, and it may not work out like you think, that's why it is a step of faith. That step will break the log jam in that area. You cannot control the result so don't even try to do so. That is God's area. Turn it over to Him.
